**Green Lake Lutheran Ministries asks that you share the following with your group:**

The camp is for your use, growth, and enjoyment. To enable this to become a reality, we ask you to support the following guidelines while at Green Lake's campus:

- A) Please be prepared to share such facilities as the dining hall, recreation areas, grounds, equipment, etc. with other retreat groups that may be at the camp when you are there. Often there is more than one group at camp at one time.
- B) In respect for our neighbors and others, we ask that campers not leave the camp grounds without permission from the Group Leader and that all outside activities cease by 11 PM.
- C) "Lights out" time is for the Group Leaders to cooperatively establish. Our staff will invite all Leaders to a short meeting the first evening to establish lights out time. NOTE: It is the responsibility of YOUR staff to support, follow and uphold these guidelines with your group. The camp recommends that you have one adult staff person per sleeping room with all youth groups.
- D) Please leave the camp building and grounds as neat and clean as possible. The Staff will assist you and your campers in cleaning up your area before you leave camp.
- E) Personal radio, tape decks, etc. are best left at home, unless they are to be used as part of your group as well as members of other groups.
- F) State law does not permit pets at camp.
- G) Snowmobiling will be permitted only on designated trails and when driven by an experienced adult. The camp does not carry insurance for snowmobile injuries.
- H) Because of the danger factors, please do not enter the lake (fall or spring) or walk on the ice without permission of our Staff. Each Group Leader should check with the GLLM staff concerning the advisability of swimming or walking on the ice.
- I) Alcoholic beverages and mood altering drugs are prohibited on camp property. Smoking is restricted to designated areas and to adults only.
- J) The Group Leader will be responsible for any unnecessary breakage, damage or vandalism caused by his/her group.
- K) Please park all cars in the parking lots provided. Check with our Staff for assigned parking lots.
- L) Please allow time at the beginning of your schedule for a welcome and orientation by our staff to acquaint you with the camp, explain policies and procedures, and to answer questions.
- M) Safety is very important. Please be careful in all that you do. The camp does provide secondary accident insurance, but does not provide health insurance.
- N) We as a staff want to do our utmost to help your experience be a positive one.
